The **2019 ADURS Symposium** is designed for pharmacists specializing in medication utilization within State Medicaid programs and is sponsored by the American Drug Utilization Review Society (ADURS) and the Nebraska Council for Continuing Pharmacy Education (NCCPE). NCCPE is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) as a provider of continuing pharmacy education. Credit for courses must be earned by the participant. Participants will earn **12.50 contact hours** of continuing pharmacy education (CPE) credits for attendance of the entire symposium.

In order to earn CPE credits, the participant must complete an on-line educational evaluation form for each CPE session they attend within 15 days from the end of the symposium. The evaluation will collect birthdate (MMDD) and NABP e-Profile ID number (to receive CPE credits, the attendee must have an NABP e-Profile ID number).
